Matthew 6:9–13 (NKJV) : 9...Our Father in heaven, Hallowed be Your name.10Your kingdom come. Your will be done On earth as it is in heaven.11Give us this day our daily bread.12And forgive us our debts, As we [have already forgiven] our debtors. 13And do not lead us into temptation, But deliver us from the evil one. Teach Us To Pray So We Are Not Guilty of Vain Repetition

Genesis 24:45 (NASB) : Before I had finished speaking in my heart, behold, Rebekah came out with her jar on her shoulder, and went down to the spring and drew, and I said to her, 'Please let me drink.'

Teach Us To Pray So We Know What Pleases God

Genesis 24:7 (NASB) : The LORD, the God of heaven, who took me from my father's house and from the land of my birth, and who spoke to me and who swore to me, saying, 'To your descendants I will give this land,' He will send His angel before you, and you will take a wife for my son from there.

Hebrews 10:32–39 (NASB) : But remember the former days, when, after being enlightened, you endured a great conflict of sufferings, 33partly by being made a public spectacle through reproaches and tribulations, and partly by becoming sharers with those who were so treated. 34For you showed sympathy to the prisoners and accepted joyfully the seizure of your property, knowing that you have for yourselves a better possession and a lasting one. 35Therefore, do not throw away your confidence, which has a great reward. 36For you have need of endurance, so that when you have done the will of God, you may receive what was promised. 37FOR YET IN A VERY LITTLE WHILE, HE WHO IS COMING WILL COME, AND WILL NOT DELAY. 38BUT MY RIGHTEOUS ONE SHALL LIVE BY FAITH; AND IF HE SHRINKS BACK, MY SOUL HAS NO PLEASURE IN HIM. 39But we are not of those who shrink back to destruction, but of those who have faith to the preserving of the soul.

Hebrews 11:1 (NASB) : Now faith is the assurance of things hoped for, the conviction of things not seen.

Hebrews 11:6 (NASB) : And without faith it is impossible to please Him, for he who comes to God must believe that He is and that He is a rewarder of those who seek Him.

Teach Us To Pray So We Can Have Hope For The Future

Genesis 24:56 (NASB) : He said to them, "Do not delay me, since the LORD has prospered my way. Send me away that I may go to my master."

Romans 5:5 (NASB) : and hope does not disappoint, because the love of God has been poured out within our hearts through the Holy Spirit who was given to us.

Hope Produces Courage In The Face of Resistance

Teach Us To Pray So We Can Know When We Are Finished

Genesis 24:26 (NASB) : *Then the man bowed low and worshiped the LORD.*

If We Know That He Hears, We Know That We Have

Matthew 17:20 (NASB) : *And He said to them, "Because of the littleness of your faith; for truly I say to you, if you have faith the size of a mustard seed, you will say to this mountain, 'Move from here to there,' and it will move; and nothing will be impossible to you.*

Romans 15:4–5 (NASB) : *For whatever was written in earlier times was written for our instruction, so that through perseverance and the encouragement of the Scriptures we might have hope. 5Now may the God who gives perseverance and encouragement grant you to be of the same mind with one another according to Christ Jesus,*

Mark 11.22–24 (EXP) : *and answering, Jesus says to them, be constantly having faith in God. Truly, I am saying to you, whoever says to this mountain, Be lifted up and be thrown into the sea, and does not doubt in his heart but believes that that which he says comes to pass, it shall be his. On this account I am saying to you, all things whatever you are praying and asking for, be believing that you received them, and they shall be yours.*

Many times, we do not see answers to prayer because we are praying for things we already have.
